Our parish **Spiritual Development Commission** and **Outreach for Peace and Justice Commission** have worked together to offer this once in a lifetime weekend. It promises to be not only a weekend of renewal and growth, but also one that inspirationally challenges us to become all we are capable of becoming as a community of believers.
